



Dear customer,

We acknowledge a common issue with the MS_Office environment which prevents users from running macros in their machines.

If you are facing the following error message while running one of the UIT Excel tools/macros:



This error is generally caused by the latest update of windows (KB2726958) of the Microsoft Office Security patch of December 2014.

Solutions:

1 - Manual

Problem should be solved by deleting two folders from the cache memory in your workstation:

- 1. Access the hard drive. Probably C:\
- 2. Find and open the Users folder in the hard drive directory.
- 3. Open your "user_name" folder (e.g. James)
- 4. Open the AppData folder:

If this folder is not visible:

- Select from the menu bar: Tools -> Folder Options -> View Tab -> Check the bullet: Show hidden files, folder, drives -> Apply.
- Close this window. Open the AppData folder.
- 5. Open the Local folder
- 6. Open the Temp folder
- 7. Delete the folders: Excel8.0 and VBE
- 8. Run the macro again

2 - U IT fix utility

From your browser, type in the URL field: www.uit.lu/sofie/Fix_Rt438.zip

- 1. Download and extract the content of this zip file.
- 2. Run the included .exe file and answer "y" to the question.
- 3. If you don't have the permission to run applications in your machine please ask some advice from your IT department.
- 4. Run the macro again.

3 - Microsoft Fix

Please refer to the explanation given by Microsoft on their Technet blog regarding this issue.

Other reasons:

1 - ActiveX controls disabled in Excel

Ensure the ActiveX controls are not disabled in the Excel confidentiality center (Excel => Options => Trust Center => ActiveX Settings)

2 - Group Policies

Please verify with you IT department the Windows domain GPO for any further restriction set. Practical example can be found here

3 - Security tool (Anti-Virus, Anti-XXX, other)
